### 1. Budge (Verb):

**Meaning** : make or cause to make the slightest movement

**Synonyms** : move, shift, change position, stir, give way, go

**Antonyms** : Discourage, Hinder, Hold, Keep

### 2. Averse (Adj):

**Meaning** : having a strong dislike of or opposition to something

**Synonyms** : opposed to, against, antipathetic to, hostile to, antagonistic to

**Antonyms** : keen

### 3. Gist (Noun):

**Meaning** : the substance or general meaning of a speech or text.

**Synonyms** : Essence, substance, quintessence, main idea/theme, central idea/theme

**Antonyms** : Outside, Surface, Meaninglessness

### 4. Merely (Adj):

**Meaning** : just; only

**Synonyms** : Only, purely, solely, simply, entirely, just

**Antonyms** : Indefinitely

### 5. Conciliatory (Adj):

**Meaning** : intended or likely to placate or pacify

**Synonyms** : Propitiatory, placatory, appeasing, pacifying, pacific, mollifying

**Antonyms** : antagonistic

### 6. Amount to (Verb) :

**Meaning** : to become a particular amount.

### 7. Phase out (Verb):

**Meaning** : a gradual stopping (as in operations or production) : a closing down by phases

**Synonyms** : Cancel, Eliminate, Terminate

### 8. Primacy (Noun):

**Meaning** : the fact of being pre-eminent or most important

**Synonyms** : greater importance, priority, precedence, pre-eminence, preference, superiority

### 9. Creeping (Verb):

**Meaning** : (of a negative characteristic or fact) occurring or developing gradually and almost imperceptibly.

**Synonyms** : crawl, move on all fours, move on hands and knees

### 10. Subtle (Adj):

**Meaning** : (especially of a change or distinction) so delicate or precise as to be difficult to analyze or describe.

**Synonyms** : Crude
