

DAILY VOCABULARY (11.10.2019)

1. **SLUMP (Verb):**

Meaning : undergo a sudden severe or prolonged fall in price, value, or amount

Synonyms : plummet, plunge, tumble, decline

Antonyms : rise, ascend, grow, soar

2. **SIEGE (Noun):**

Meaning : a military operation in which enemy forces surround a town or building, cutting off essential supplies, with the aim of compelling those inside to surrender

Synonyms : blockade, barricade, restriction

Antonyms : clearance, opening

3. **TIZZY (Noun):**

Meaning : a state of nervous excitement or agitation

Synonyms : acrimony, animosity, annoyance, chagrin

Antonyms : calm, calmness, delight, ease

4. **FARRAGO (Noun):**

Meaning : a confused mixture

Synonyms : mishmash, jumble, hodgepodge, turmoil

Antonyms : constituent, ravel, sequence, categorization.

5. **REBOUND (Verb):**

Meaning : If an action rebounds on you, it does not have the effect you hoped for but has an unpleasant effect on you instead

Synonyms : bounce back, spring back, boomerang

6. **HABITUAL (Adj) :**

Meaning : usual or repeated

Synonyms : addicted, perpetual, accustomed

Antonyms : infrequent, occasional

7. **SPLENDID (Adj):**

Meaning : excellent, or beautiful and impressive

Synonyms : excellent, amazing

Antonyms : dull, normal

8. **CONSTERNATION (Noun):**

Meaning : a feeling of anxiety or dismay, typically at something unexpected

Synonyms : perturbation, anxiety, distress, disquiet

Antonyms : calmness, composure, coolness, peace

9. **MOOT (Adj):**

Meaning : subject to debate, dispute, or uncertainty

Synonyms : debatable, arguable, problematic, contentious

Antonyms : certain, definite

10. **Reprimand (Noun):**

Meaning : a formal expression of disapproval

Synonyms : rebuke, reproof, admonishment, admonition

Antonyms : compliment, praise, commendation, reward
